
List of people enslaved by Francis Fincher Gist in 1819

When Francis Fincher Gist died in 1819, there were 33 enslaved people listed as property in his estate. See below the names of the enslaved individuals in this estate document, which dehumanizes each human being by assigning them a market value. Francis' twelve year old son, William Henry Gist, inherited 23 of the enslaved people in the estate and Francis' wife Anne inherited the other 10 individuals.



The 23 people highlighted in yellow were given to a twelve year old William Henry Gist and the individuals in red were inherited by Francis' wife Anne Stewart.
